Sometimes he even got to satisfy that sweet tooth with an even-over trade on that GM Horsepower for Cigarettes and some chocolate. Soon the kids started and the family and the business grew. 3 boys, Brad, Brent, and Brian, they helped with many aspects of the business. Roger was so proud he bought his first new car a 1971 Chevrolet Corvette. The kids were so excited when he brought the car home. The family still has this car and now in the car of one of the boys.

Roger's collection was like a box of chocolates, you just can't eat one, and he just couldn't have 1 car. Soon the collection grew.
